

Clean Intermittent Catheterization Instructions

- Assemble equipment together and place in an accessible area.
 <u>Equipment needed</u>:
 Catheter
 Water soluble lubricant
 Moist towelette or soap and water
 Dry hand towel
- 2. Inspect the catheter before use. Do not use product if there is damage to the catheter.
- 3. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water, and dry.
- 4. Position yourself comfortably with thighs spread apart. For many women, they prefer to either sit directly on the toilet or on a chair across from the toilet.
- 5. With one hand, separate the labia and wash from <u>front to back</u> with either a moist towelette or soap and water.
- 6. Lubricate the catheter tip that will be inserted into the urethra.
- 7. Slowly and gently insert the catheter into the urethra until urine begins to flow. Keep the catheter in place until urine stops flowing.
- 8. When urine flow stops, begin to remove the catheter until the entire catheter is removed.
- 9. Check the color, odor and clarity of the urine and be aware of any changes that may need to be reported to your doctor or nurse.
